We are netting a \$300 positive on the budget.

CAA did not charge us for Alumni House rental.

We saved \$500 on not sending out mailings asking for help with basketball games.

We are doing better on memberships.

We have a 21% return this year on investment of lifetime memberships which comes out to 1.9% total to date.
